



# CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD

## TRAIN NUMBERS

Every train originating on the CPRR is assigned a train number. Train numbers are alpha/numeric and consist of two letters and the locomotive number. The first letter is the originating yard and the second letter is the destination, i.e. York-Midway is YM plus the locomotive number, i.e. YM35. Trains may destinations may be combined on one train. For example YJM would be the symbol for Jimville/Midway.

YK	KNAT yard
YF	FM staging yard

### Locals Originating at KNAT Yard

KS	Strickler
KP	Potter
KB	Branch Line (also called FMCL)
KY	York yard
KF	FM staging yard
KH	Hall staging yard
KSH	Shop staging yard

Off line train order numbers originating at staging yards are also alpha numeric starting with the first letter or first two letters of the originating yard name and the first letter of the destination yard. For example: FMS is Furnace Mountain to Shop; HY is Hall to York, etc. The addition of the locomotive number completes the train order number. It should be noted that off line train orders are only prepared by the Superintendent so details are not included on this page.
